





A sample of 266 students participated in online feedback exercise and answered various questions






31% Students found their programme of study as the best option for them, however 7% students felt that their programme of study could not be rated as the best option for them, these students were not satisfied with the programme. Taking a serious note of that Statutory body passed the mandate that from the next session students should be provided enough counselling during admission process about the course they are opting as this will reduce the level of discomfort about the course in students as well as teachers will be able to understand the expectations of students. As the dissatisfaction was not there about the

faculty, 74.4% students reported that the faculty were easily reachable during the programme/course
